The municipal theatre is located in Can Saragossa Park, close to the Monterrey Hotel and to the Conference Centre and Gran Casino Costa Brava. The theatre accommodates 370 people and has three rehearsal rooms. The project is by Domènech i Girbau, great-grandson of Domènech i Montaner and designer of the building of the Crown of Aragon, the new Theatre Institute of Barcelona and the Federico García Lorca Centre in Granada, amongst others.



9.30 h Site inspection at **Delamar Hotel**

The Delamar Hotel is located on the main avenue of Lloret de Mar, just 100 metres from the beach. Its bohemian and vintage design offers a new interpretation of the urban beach hotel. It boasts a fascinating mixture of Mediterranean and Cuban influences.



10.15 h Site inspection at **Evenia Olympic Palace**

Evenia Olympic Resort can host events up to 2,500 people as it holds its own congress centre and 15 meetings. The resort has a total of 793 rooms



11.00 h Transfer to Mona Foundation

11.30 h CSR Activity in **La Mona Foundation**

Mona Foundation is a rehabilitation center for chimpanzees and moccasins who have been in circus, show televisions, in advertising or have just been simply pets. Many of them have lived long years in absolute solitude and terrible conditions but in Mona Foundation they help them recover living in a natural environment.

14.15 h Lunch & site inspection at **Hotel Camiral in PGA Catalunya**
